Dear Parents and Families

As I am sure the children told you before the weekend, in our assembly on Friday morning, we celebrated the life of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II and held a period of reflection which was observed immaculately by everyone. We reminded the children of the book and mug they received to mark the occasion of the Platinum Jubilee earlier this year and watched the Paddington Bear 'Marmalade Sandwich' video, to show the Queen's remarkable sense of humour and fun.
